Many changes have been made in this revision of the Interactive Public Map in an attempt to meet ADA Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 compliancy standards. Please note that we are utilizing many new HTML5 features and elements which are not supported by older browsers.

- 1. All tools and popup content have been moved to the right side panel.
- 2. The Base Map and Hybrid buttons are now combined into a single Base Maps and Imagery panel.
- 3. A Swipe Imagery Tool has been added to the Base Maps and Imagery panel.
- 4. Layers panel was renamed to Additional Overlay Layers.
- 5. Layer transparency sliders have been converted to HTML5 range elements with current value display.
- 6. Drawing and Measuring Tools have been moved to the right side panel with additional features.
- 7. Colors are selected by clicking on the box with the hexadecimal value to reveal popup color selector.
- 8. Additional drawing pens have been added (Arrow, Ellipse, Triangle, and Rectangle).
- 9. Text drawing now allows halos with the ability to set the colors of the font and halo.
- 10. Drawing graphics and text can be edited by clicking on the graphic / text.
- 11. Measure tools now include an XY location tool with selectable coordinate system.
- 12. Distance and Area tools now allow the user to select length units and area units.
- 13. Measuring tools honor the colors set in the Drawing Pen and Drawing Text options.
- 14. The user can delete individual drawing and measurement graphics by pressing CTRL and clicking on the graphic.
- 15. The Print function has been moved to the right side panel under Print and Additional Tools.
- 16. Added a Shapefile Upload feature that also honors the colors set in the Drawing Pen options.
- 17. Map zoom buttons have been modified to be accessible by keyboard.
- 18. Additional map pan buttons have been added to make map navigation more accessible by keyboard.
- 19. Aria tags and landmarks have been added for more robust screen reader accessibility.
- 20. Improved keyboard accessibility through entire site.
